

PARENT'S EXPECTATIONS OF GAB HEALTH SERVICES

The primary purpose of our medical department is health maintenance. To accomplish this goal we work very closely with parents or guardians, encouraging them to play an active role in the decision making process.

Parents can expect that:

1. Medications and treatments prescribed by a doctor will be given as ordered.
2. Children can see our staff physician on Wednesday mornings.
3. Children will be admitted to Health Services should the need arise. Parents will be consulted when the nurses feel the child needs to be at home.
4. Parents will be notified when immunization certificates need to be updated. Immunization certificates must be correct. This is state law. This is the parent's responsibility.
5. Generally a nurse can be reached in Health Services. Our nurses will be glad you called and will be happy to speak to you about any health concerns. Our Health Services number is:
