It is with a heavy heart that we address the tragic events that occurred today at Apalachee High School in Winder, GA. Our deepest sympathies and prayers are with all those impacted by this senseless act of violence. In times like these, we are reminded of the sacred trust you place in us every day when you send your children to our schools. We do not take that responsibility lightly.

At Georgia State Schools, the safety and security of our students are our top priority. We are committed to creating a safe learning environment through a comprehensive approach that includes significant investments in security systems, state-of-the-art mass communication technology, exterior & interior access control measures. Each classroom is equipped with robust access control hardware to ensure the safety of our students and staff when in a lockdown situation.

Our staff members are thoroughly trained in various life-saving techniques including CPR/AED, Stop the Bleed, Citizens Response to an Active Shooter Event (CRASE), and Intruder Response. We drill for a variety of emergency-related events on a regular basis. We maintain strong partnerships with local and state law enforcement as well as multiple emergency response agencies. By conducting regular safety drills and training alongside our community partners, we are prepared to respond effectively in any emergency.

We want to assure you that school safety remains at the forefront of all that we do. We are steadfast in our commitment to protecting your children and will continue to take every measure possible to keep our schools safe and secure.

Thank you for your trust and partnership as we navigate these challenging times together.


